Any sophomore or junior student who is interested in taking Vo-Tech classes next year at the Hutchinson Career & Technical Education Academy (HC&TEA) need to see Mr. Snyder for an application. Applications are due April 4th.

**Summer Internship**-Hutchinson Regional Healthcare System Academy Student Program offers a junior or senior student the opportunity to internship at the hospital this summer. This is a paid internship. Students must be 16 years of age, and have a 3.25 GPA. The eight-week program begins on June 4, 2018. The application is due March 23rd.
