Reports

Updates

- **Good Sports Store:** We NEED a coordinator!!!!
 - Cleared out old inventory and will have new items at Madness.
- **Concessions:**
 - Outside concession stand has been improved, reorganized, and more. Special food nights are already scheduled. Sept. 5 will be street tacos- with all proceeds going to Booster Club. Special homecoming meal has not been planned yet.
 - Still struggling to pass information from shift to shift. Perhaps have a contact around the whole evening but not necessarily in the stand the whole time. Essentially a supervisor for the night. Megan Hammersmith said could do almost all the set ups.
 - Inside concession cart necessities will be able to roll in to use. Take note of what is still needed so we can have our own supplies and not use the items from the kitchen.
 - Thank you for all who helped with the clean up night. Coaches will use the deep freeze for ice needs. Also, we have new iPads and square stands. You don't have to keep track or calculate prices anymore!
 - Clubs and teams- yes we will offer to clubs and teams again. \$100 a night, Friday night \$200. Everything must be clean to earn the money. Only parents allowed to handle money.
 - Volunteer information night? Supervisor training instead? Training before first football/volleyball game? We will discuss further
- **Football Mania:** reduced requirement to 5 tickets. 5 x 150 families = \$10,500. We plan to send updates out to parents letting them know our progress
- **Teacher Appreciation Coordinators:** NEED Teacher Pantry items!!!

 - We will do Traveling Bowl for teachers during Catholic Schools Week.
- **Madness:** Meet at the field, blessing on students, food, new merch for the good sport store. We could use volunteers. Boosters provide a shirt as gift to faculty and coaches who wanted one.

New Business

- **Pop a Shot:** would like to continue if possible. Something for football? Check with Strecker to make sure won't conflict and have something can throw through. Made about \$700 last year. There are regulations for students who are on the teams participating.
- **Eagle Scout Request:** Pennycuff twins created a prayer garden. They are working on raised flower bed. Booster Club is welcome to donate, and they can put in some hanging planters or additional pots if want and they will add them. Check it out if you get the chance. Perhaps an additional statue.

- **Window Replacements:** Still need to replace windows in the outside concession stand. Looking to replace 3 windows. Does anyone have a contact or would be willing look into? Kyle will look at the windows. We are hoping for \$1,000 or less.

Old Business

- Nurse's bag purchased, outside lighting completed- look if you get a chance to see if additional lighting is needed anywhere
- Vape sensors for bathrooms are a work in progress- detect noises, words, vape. Window tints still being worked on.
- Secure entry remodel will happen over Christmas Break. Buzzing in will only admit you into the office not into the building without going through office. Cheaper to do all work in one shot over Christmas instead of splitting the project in parts. Door locks we will look at after final costs of entry model
