Treasurer:

- Concession stand is doing very well! Almost double what we were doing last year.
- \$52,268.42 in account right now if you take out our Fund-A-Need money that still needs to be paid out.

Development Updates:

- Annual Fund: \$125,000 is the goal. Thank you for donations that we have already received! We have currently collected \$105,000
- Gym Campaign: still owe just under \$70,000. Contact has been made with individuals who promised funds to the campaign. You can always make new donations as well!
- Year end Letters: we will be working on thank you notes to our donors
- Homecoming: An alumni "tent" will be in the library. There will be old year books, free popcorn, and great socialization. They will also stream the game in the library for those who want to socialize while watching the game.
- Auction: This is our BIG fundraiser! Now is time for all hands-on deck!

Teacher Appreciation: Teacher lunch on Tuesday of Catholic Schools Week. We will collect orders from teachers for the Traveling Bowl. Boosters is covering the cost for this.

Fund a Need

- The front entry was not completed over Christmas Break. Bids for this job were much higher than expected
 - Plans are currently being reworked and then will be sent out for new bids and hopefully done over Spring Break
- We received a new donation to Fund a Need from Landmark
- We purchased the cleaning machine that was approved at our November meeting and split the cost with the school- \$3,567
 - It works great!!!

Concessions:

- We will have walking tacos for Thursday 1/15 and Friday 1/16
- Planning to have pulled pork sandwiches and baked potatoes for Past Parent Night. We will offer an option of putting pork on the potato. There is a concern about the mess from the condiment table. We might need more volunteers to help manage the condiments.
- We discussed the possibility of purchasing a Hot Dog Roller or Pretzel warmer for our concession stand. Having a good hot dog meal option could allow for us to offer than instead of Chick-Fil-A. We only make about \$1 per sandwich.
- Theater is going to sell candy at games to advertise for their upcoming production of Willy Wonka and the Chocolate Factory. Students will dress up as Oompa Loompas and include a golden ticket in the candies to win a ticket to the show
- We would like to stream the games in the concession stand. We agreed to purchase a Booster Club owned laptop that could be used for this and other events/booster club work.
- We need volunteers!!!
- Looking to get some better carts for wheeling candy back and forth.
